The writ application filed by the petitioner was allowed on 23rd of July, 2007 directing that the claims of the petitioner be scrutinized and if anything is due and payable to the petitioner, the same be paid to him in addition to the pension. In terms of such direction, an order has been passed on 23rd of January, 2008 (Annexure-F) to the show-cause finding that a sum of Rs. 94,547/- is due and payable to the petitioner.

Since an order has been passed, the petitioner would have



a remedy to challenge the said order in accordance with law before an appropriate forum.

The Contempt Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
