Heard the parties.

This application, for grant of anticipatory bail,
arises out of Nokha P.S. Case No. 102 of 2016, disclosing
offences under Sections 302, 201 and 120B of the Indian
Penal Code.

Considering the nature of accusation, I am not
inclined to grant the petitioners, above named, the



privilege of anticipatory bail.

This application is, accordingly, rejected.
