2 12-10-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners, learned
A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the opposite party no.
2.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case
for the offence registered under Sections 323, 341, 504, 506,
498(A), 302/34 of the IPC and ¾ of the D. P. Act.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that the accused
persons including the petitioners killed the victim due to non-
fulfillment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted by learned counsel for the
petitioners that the petitioners have falsely been implicated in the



present case due to petty family dispute. There is no allegation of tampering with the witnesses alleged against the petitioners. The petitioners are in-laws of the victim. They are separate in mess and property from the husband of the deceased. The husband of the deceased is in custody.

On behalf of the learned counsels for the State and opposite party no. 2, it has been submitted that the petitioners are named in the F.I.R/ complaint case.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioners above named, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Nalanda at Bihar Sharif, in connection with Bihar P.S. Case No. 344/2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
