2      19-08-2017      Heard learned counsel for the parties.

This application for anticipatory bail arises out of  
Complaint Case NO. 2173 of 2016, disclosing offences under  
Sections 498A,406 of the Indian Penal Code and Sections 3/4  
of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Petitioner is the husband of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner is ready to keep the complainant with full honour,  
love and dignity.

It is evident from the materials on record that  
matrimonial discord between the wife and husband is the root  
cause for registration of the First Information Report. No



purpose will be served, if the petitioner is taken into custody.

It is submitted that the petitioner shall present himself before the police as and when required and there is no chance that he will tamper with the evidence or influence the witnesses.

Considering the nature of accusation and submissions advanced on behalf of the petitioner, this application is allowed.

Let the petitioner above named in the event of his arrest/surrender within six weeks from today in the Court below, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran in Complaint Case No. 2173 of 2016 ( SC No. 1201 of 2017), subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

This is subject to the condition that the petitioner shall present himself before the Police/Court, as the case may be, as and when required and in the event of failure on his part to appear before the Court on two consecutive occasions, his bail bonds shall be liable to be cancelled.
