3 02-03-2017 The writ application was dismissed on the ground of extraordinary delay and laches since the writ was filed in the year 2012 for an advertisement for appointment to the post of Constable in the year 1998.

If that was not bad enough, the present appeal has also been filed after an inordinate delay of 299 days for which the



explanation offered is far from satisfactory that the appellants are poor people. There is no separate law for poor people so far as limitation aspect is concerned.

Since the writ was frivolous and so is the appeal, the limitation petition as well as the appeal are dismissed.
