3 08-09-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Ramgarh P.S. Case No. 238 of 2016 registered for the offence punishable under section 307 and other allied sections of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that nothing specific has been alleged against these petitioners. Specific allegation is against co-accused persons. Only one injury has been found. After investigation, final form has been submitted in the case. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions of advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender



within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on
furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two
sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of S.J.M.,
Kaimur at Bhabhua in connection with Ramgarh P.S. Case No.
238 of 2016 subject to the conditions laid down under section
438(2) Cr.P.C.
