3 10-08-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioners are seeking anticipatory
bail in connection with Chausa P.S. Case No.17 of 2017,
registered for the offence punishable under Sections 341, 323,
307, 354, 448 and 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

From the record, it appears that both sides have
attacked on each other and both sides have received injuries.
From the case diary, it appears that it was a momentous fight.

Looking to the aforesaid facts, let the above-named
petitioners, namely, Ashok Sah, Sikendra Sah and Anirudh Sah
be released on anticipatory bail in the event of their arrest or



surrender before the learned Court below within a period of six weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the S.D.J.M., Udakishunganj at Madhepura, in connection with Chausa P.S. Case No.17 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
