Heard Mr. Aditya Nath Pandey, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. Sanjay Kumar, learned ASG appearing along with Mr. Anjani Kumar Sharan, CGC for the respondents.

The petitioner has been disqualified for appointment on the ground of medical unfitness, vide order as contained in Annexure-2 and even the appeal has been rejected vide order as contained in Annexure-4 as not being in prescribed proforma and not accompanied with the supporting documents.

The matter relates to appointment to the uniform service and passage of time of almost a decade does not persuade this Court



to grant indulgence to the prayer made for the fault lies entirely on the petitioner in not pursuing his remedy in the manner required

The writ application is, accordingly, disposed of.
