Considering the fact that after the cut off date fixed by the Supreme Court i.e. 30th of September, there is no provision for admission to Medical Courses, learned Writ Court has not committed any error in dismissing the writ petition. Once the cut off date for admission fixed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court i.e. 30th of September, 2015 is over, the petitioner cannot seek any benefit for admission to the Course in question after 30th of September of the



year in question and therefore, we see no reason to make any indulgence into the matter.

The appeal stands dismissed.
