3 01-09-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with Nabinagar P.S. Case No. 207 of 2016 registered for the offence punishable under sections 30(a)/38 of the Bihar Excise (Amendment) Act, 2016.

Learned counsels appearing for the petitioner submits that petitioner is not named in the first information report. Nothing has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. Except the fact that the alleged vehicle is registered in the name of this petitioner, nothing has come against this petitioner. As a matter of fact, petitioner had sold the vehicle to one Govardhan Das, however petitioner's name is still appearing in the ownerbook.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions of advanced on behalf of the parties, let the



petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Sessions Judge VII-cum-Special Judge, Aurangabad in connection with Nabinagar P.S. Case No. 207 of 2016 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
