learned counsel for the State.

The present application has been filed for quashing the First Information Report of Vibhutipur P.S. Case No. 106 of 2016 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 171(E) and 47(a) of Bihar Excise Amendment Act, 2016, pending in the court of learned ACJM-III, Rosera, Samastipur.

Mr. Ambika Bhagat, learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly submits that the investigation has already concluded, though the charge sheet has been submitted under



Sections 504 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code.
