ORAL ORDER

3 12-12-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Alamganj P.S. Case No. 154 of 2016 registered under Sections 409 of the Indian Penal Code and section 42(D) of the Bihar Self Supporting Co-operative Societies Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that the specific allegation against the co-accused Dilip Kumar. Further submission is that petitioners had already resigned from their posts prior to passing of the order of liquidation of the present society.

Having considered the facts and circumstances of the



case, let the above named petitioners be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.C.J.M., Patna City in connection with Alamganj P.S. Case No. 154 of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
