4 28-01-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 363/366A of
the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation is that the petitioners and co-accused
Nishant Kumar Singh kidnapped the minor daughter of the
informant, namely, Sabana Khatoon.

Submission of the petitioner is that case-diary would
reveal that the witnesses have stated that the matter was of love-
affairs and co-accused Nishant has fled away with Sabana
Khatoon. Since the petitioners are the family members of Nishant



Kumar Singh, hence, they are suspected.

Considering the facts aforesaid, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Mrs. Divya Shekhar, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Saran at Chapra/Successor Court in connection with Sahajitpur Police Station Case No.49 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
