3 08-12-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Bettiah
Town P.S. Case No. 204 of 2017 registered for the offence
punishable under sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that
petitioners are the father-in-law and mother-in-law of the
deceased. Nothing specific has been alleged against them. They
have been falsely implicated in this case merely because they
are relatives of the husband of the deceased. Petitioners resides
separately from the husband of the deceased and they had no
concern with the affairs of wife and husband. Petitioners have
no criminal antecedent.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran in connection with Bettiah Town P.S. Case No. 204 of 2017 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
