learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with  
Runnisaaidpur P.S. Case No. 452 of 2017 registered under Sections  
30(g)/38(1)(2)/30 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner  
submits that petitioner is doing job in Srinagar, Jammu and  
Kashmir. The Company has issued a certificate on 04.10.2017  
certifying that at that time, petitioner was present at the project  
site and Mukhiya of the Gram Panchayat also issued a certificate  
certifying that petitioner has not visited his ancestral house, which  
would appear from Annexure nos. 2 and 3. Further submission is  
that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of  
the petitioner.



Having considered the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner be released on bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the A.D.J.-II, Sitamarhi in connection with Runnisaidpur P.S. Case No. 452 of 2017, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr. P.C.
