ORAL ORDER

4 05-07-2017 On the insistence of the parties, the writ application is disposed of in the following terms in the pre-sitting of Lok Adalat:

- i) The petitioner will make a representation before the competent authority that he is not getting pension in para-materia to his salary.
- ii) On receipt of the representation, the respondents would adjudicate the same within a period of two months.
- iii) In case the petitioner is aggrieved, he would be at liberty to file a petition for reviving the instant case.
- iv) On filing of such petition, the writ petition would stands revived.

The instant settlement would form part of Lok Adalat to be held on 8.7.2017.
