Heard learned counsel for the petitioners and

learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341/323/324/307/379/354/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

For land dispute an occurrence of assault allegedly took place.

Submission is that the person, who allegedly assaulted, have already been allowed anticipatory bail by a coordinate Bench of this Court in Cr. Misc. No.32519 of 2017. There is no allegation of commission of assault against the petitioners.



Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.20,000/- (Twenty Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court-below where the case is pending in connection with Rajapur Police Station Case No. 146 of 2017, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as condition that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation/trial of the case, failing which the court below shall be at liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioners.
