3 23-03-2017 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner
and the State.

This is a petition for grant of anticipatory bail
for offence under Sections 323, 342, 385, 498A and
504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is husband. The allegation is
under Section 498A of the Indian Penal Code. The
petitioner is ready for restitution of conjugal life.

The wife, opposite party no. 2, has appeared
and she is also ready for restitution of conjugal life.

In the circumstances, let the petitioner, above
named, in the event of his arrest or surrender, within four
weeks from the date of receipt of this order, be released
on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten
thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in
connection with **Bhojpur Mahila P.S. Case No. 52 of**



2016 to the satisfaction of the **Subdivisional Judicial Magistrate, Bhojpur at Ara**, or successor Court, subject to the conditions laid down under Section 438(2) of the Criminal Procedure Code and both the spouses shall appear voluntarily before the Court below, who shall ensure restoration of conjugal life between the parties.
