3 12-12-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

Petitioners apprehend arrest in connection with Karjain P.S.

Case No. 57 of 2016 registered for the offence punishable under sections 341, 323, 448, 328, 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that petitioners have been implicated in this case due to dirty village politics. As a matter of fact, the deceased was of unsound mind and was suffering from mental disease. None has assaulted the deceased. During investigation, daughter and husband of the deceased were examined and they have not stated anything against these petitioners. Petitioners have no criminal antecedent.



Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri A.K. Pandey, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, birpur, Supaul in connection with Karjain P.S. Case No. 57 of 2016 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
