Petitioner apprehends his arrest in **Shikarpur P.S.**

Case No.317 of 2017 instituted for the offence under Section(s)
409, 420/34 Indian Penal Code.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the
petitioner has given statement during enquiry, which is part of the
First Information Report, that he was taking the rice and two Kg.
Masoor for his personal use after purchasing from local shop. It
is further submitted that it is unbelievable that Headmaster of the
school will carry rice of Mid Day Meal openly on a motorcycle.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, prayer of
the petitioner for grant of anticipatory bail is allowed. In the



event of surrender/arrest of the petitioner, named above, within six weeks from today in connection with **Shikarpur P.S. Case No.317 of 2017**, he shall be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the **Chief Judicial Magistrate, West Chamapran, Bettiah**, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr. P. C. with further conditions: (1) bailors should be local having sufficient immovable property within the jurisdiction of the court concerned, (2) petitioner shall cooperate in the trial and shall be present on each and every date fixed by the court and absence on two consecutive dates without proper and reasonable reason will automatically cancel bail bond of the petitioner and (3) if petitioner tampers with the evidence or the witnesses of the case, in that case, prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of bail of the petitioner.
