this writ petition is allowed and the impugned order dated 19.05.2009 is, hereby, quashed and the matter is remitted to the competent authority with direction to pass afresh order in accordance with law after making proper enquiry as provided under Order 22 Rule 5 of the Civil Procedure Code.”
