Considering the fact that the qualification acquired by the appellant from the Nababharat Shiksha Parishad, Rourkela, Orissa is found to be not recognized by the State Government, as is evident from Paragraphs 4 and 5 of the counter affidavit filed by the State Government, we see no reason to make any indulgence into the matter. In case the appellant feels that the appellant is also entitled for consideration of her case in the light of the order passed on 13.02.2014 in C.W.J.C. No. 1634 of 2014 (Annexure-A to the counter affidavit), the appellant may approach the State Government and it is



for the State Government to consider the grievance of the appellant.

With the aforesaid liberty to the appellant, finding no indulgence to be made, the Letters Patent Appeal stands dismissed.
