counsel for the State and learned counsel appearing on behalf of

the O.P. No.2.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
instituted under Sections 498A and 365/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

The allegation against the petitioner is of committing
torture upon the victim due to non-fulfillment of the demand of
dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
there is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the
petitioner. The petitioner is father-in-law of the victim. He is
separate in mess and property from the husband of the victim. The



other co-accused have been granted bail. The petitioner has further relied upon the judgment of this court, in the case of ***Md. Naimul Haque Ansari Vs. The State of Bihar, reported in 2006(3) PLJR 182.***

On behalf of the State and counsel for the O.P. No.2, it has been submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner above named be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today in connection with Didarganj P.S. Case No.84/2017 on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Patna City, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
