Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Section 366A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Allegation against co-accused Akhilesh Kumar is that he had induced the minor daughter of the informant to go with him with intent to marry with her or for some illicit purpose. When complaint was made to the petitioners, who are family members of Akhilesh Kumar, they allegedly committed abuse and assault.

Considering the nature of allegation against the



petitioners, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of thirty days from the date of receipt of the order, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sasaram/Successor Court in connection with Sasaram (M) Police Station Case No.1132 of 2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
