4 23-11-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case registered under Sections 498A, 304B, 120B of the Indian Penal Code and $\frac{3}{4}$ of Dowry Prohibition Act.

Allegation against the accused persons including the petitioner is that they killed the daughter of the informant due to non-fulfilment of demand of dowry.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner has got no criminal antecedent. There is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. The petitioner is Devar of the deceased. He is separate in mess and property from the husband of the deceased. The husband of the



deceased is in custody.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M., Danapur in connection with Bihta P.S. case No.516 of 2016 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
