Heard learned Senior counsel for the appellant and
learned counsel for the Indian Oil Corporation.

Reason for dismissal of the writ application cannot
be said to be erroneous in any manner for the reason that the
candidature of the appellant was rejected by the Indian Oil
Corporation because of mis-declaration or wrong declaration
by him with regard to education. This position is accepted and
is not a matter of argument or dispute. If the educational



qualification declared in the application form did not match with the certification submitted, then, it is the case of mis-declaration or wrong declaration. This is good enough ground for cancellation of the candidature of the appellant. The issue must rest now. The reason is attributable to the appellant and not to the Indian Oil Corporation.

This appeal is dismissed.
