2 10-01-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a case
registered under Section 3 of the R.U. (U.P.) Act.

Allegation is that 50 bags of rice containing 50 kg each
was seized from the sugarcane field.

It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that
there is no allegation of tampering of witnesses alleged against the
petitioner. The petitioner has falsely been implicated in the
present case. The alleged recovery of rice has not been made from
the conscious possession of the petitioner. The name of the
petitioner has come on the confessional statement of the co-
accused.

On behalf of the State, it is submitted that the petitioner



is named in the F.I.R.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of six weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Railway Judicial Magistrate, West Champaran at Bettiah in connection with Narkatiyaganj R.P.F. Post case No.01/2016, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
