ORAL ORDER

5 06-10-2017 It has been pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner that in paragraph no. 1 of the order dated 21.08.2017, it has wrongly been mentioned as “challenging the order dated 28.04.2010 passed in Appeal No. 203/2009” rather the same should be “challenging the order dated 29.06.2012 passed in Appeal No. 18/2012” therefore, ‘Appeal No. 203/2009’ be read as



‘Appeal No. 18/2012’, in the said order dated 21.08.2017 passed in this case.

The petitioner is granted further 30 days time from today for filing an appeal before the State Appellate Authority and the same shall be disposed of within the statutory period.
