ORAL JUDGMENT

The petitioner will file an application before the Vice Chancellor of the University on two issues. One is the calculation of the pension which he disputes and the other is his entitlement of earned leave and the number of days of earned leave. Both matters are verifiable from the service record of the petitioner. If an application is filed with a copy of this order, the Vice Chancellor will take a decision within three months from the date



of its filing. The left over issue in relation to LIC, which has been taken note of in the previous adjournment orders, the Court is informed that the payment has been made and the details thereof have not been brought on record by way of an affidavit. However, the Court directs the officers of the LIC that they will communicate the final position with regard to his entitlement and the details thereof within four weeks from today to the petitioner. If any further grievance emerges thereof and if any infirmity is pointed out then the authorities of the LIC will re-look into the matter and indicate the final position thereto.

Writ stands disposed of in terms of the above.
