ORAL ORDER

14 14-12-2017 Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

Petitioner apprehends arrest in connection with Ghanshyampur P.S. Case No. 139 of 2016 registered for the offence punishable under sections 341, 323, 379, 498A/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that nothing specific has been alleged against this petitioner. He has been implicated in this case merely on basis of suspicion. From the allegations alleged in the first information report, no offence under section 498A I.P.C. is made out against this petitioner. There is no injury on the record to suggest any kind of assault by this petitioner. Petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the



submissions advanced on behalf of the parties, let the petitioner, above named, in the event of arrest or surrender within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Biroul, Darbhanga in connection with Ghanshyampur P.S. Case No. 139 of 2016 subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
