Nobody appears on behalf of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the State and the Accountant General are present and have assisted the Court.

2. The matter has been listed during vacation with prior notice to learned counsel that if they do not propose to conduct their matter during the Annual Vacation, a slip be filed making such request. No slip is available on record.

3. From the counter affidavit, it appears that 90%



provisional pension has been sanctioned to the petitioner as departmental proceedings are still pending and with regard to the rest, leave encashment for 300 days, gratuity and commutation of pension has also been paid. Further, benefit of ACP has also been granted to the petitioner.

4. As such payments have been made during the pendency of the writ petition and there being no rejoinder to the counter affidavit by the petitioner, the Court can only presume that the grievance of the petitioner, for the present, stands redressed.

5. In view thereof, the writ petition stands disposed off.
