Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and counsel for the State.

In this case, the petitioner has raised a grievance that the order of this Court dated 13.5.2013 in CWJC No. 10557 of 2012 has not been complied with as, in the present order, there is a direction of this Court that the petitioner will be at liberty to file representation and if he files the same, the authority will dispose of the same.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the representation filed by the petitioner has been considered in the light
