ORAL ORDER

2 23-08-2017 This application has been filed for restoration of L.P.A. No. 1417 of 2005, which is said to have been dismissed against respondent nos. 2 and 4 for non-compliance of order passed on 17.10.2011.

Office note indicates that apart from filing this restoration application, two other restoration applications, bearing M.J.C. No. 2692 of 2014 and M.J.C. No. 2765 of 2014 were filed for restoration of L.P.A. No. 1417 of 2005 and both the restoration



applications were allowed vide order passed on 21.10.2014 and the L.P.A. No. 1417 of 2005 was restored to its original file and the records indicate that the L.P.A. itself has been decided on merit and the judgment dated 7.12.2005 passed in C.W.J.C. No. 8077 of 2004 has been set aside. We are of the considered view that this application is rendered infructuous and it is accordingly dismissed.
