2 29-11-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned
A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Araria P.S. Case no. 842 of 2016, registered under Sections 461, 379
and 411 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is that informant being the Chowkidar
reached at the Public Redressal Centre, Araria then found lock of the
office was broken and the materials of the office were scattered. In the
meantime, Office Assistant Amrita Kumari reached there then it was
detected that one desk top, one printer, one scanner, two cartridges,
one keyboard and one mouse have been theft and C.P.U is lying
broken.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in course
in investigation one Santosh Malik was apprehended, who confessed



his guilt and on the basis of the confessional statement of Santosh Malik one lap top was recovered from the house of the petitioner. Further submission is that petitioner is the shopkeeper of the repairing of mobiles and laptop and the alleged recovered laptop was handed over to the petitioner by Santosh Malik for repairing the same. Moreover, in the F.I.R. it is not detailed that laptop was also stolen from the office. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, let the above named petitioner, be released on bail, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the ACJM-III, Araria in connection with Araria P.S. Case No. 842 of 2016, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Cr.P.C.
