The facts of the case, which emerges from the reading of the impugned order, does not enthruse this Bench to entertain the claim against an employee who is dead for almost 47 years. Even otherwise on the merit, the learned Single Judge has dismissed the writ application.

We are of the opinion that writ was moved as a speculative piece of litigation hoping against hope not for



enforcement of any right on behalf of the appellant.

The appeal is dismissed.
