4 20-09-2017 Today a cheque of Rs. 8,28,513 /-, dated 13.09.2017, has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner. Stand has been taken that this is full and final settlement in addition to the remaining payment of Rs. 4,16,592/-, which has been received by the petitioner on 02.09.2017.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that there is a letter, addressed to the Registrar of the university by the Principal of the college, where the amount shown payable to the petitioner is Rs. 10,93,571/-.
