In the matter of treating certain period as “No Work No
Pay” in view of involvement of the appellant in a criminal case and
the subsequent action taken, the learned Writ Court found that the
punishment imposed upon the appellant has been adjudicated on the



level of the Supreme Court and no relief has been granted and, therefore, finding no merit, the writ petition was dismissed.

We find no error in the order passed by the Writ Court warranting reconsideration. The Letters Patent Appeal is dismissed.
