the petitioners and learned A.C. to Govt. Pleader – 24.

The present petition has been filed with a prayer to restore C.W.J.C. No. 13618 of 2011, which stood dismissed due to part non-compliance of order dated 15-03-2016. By order dated 15-03-2016, peremptory order was passed for issuance of notice to respondent no. 9 to 12 through ordinary post as well as registered cover. However, requisites were filed only in respect of respondent no. 11 and 12. The reason for part non-compliance of order has categorically been explained in the petition.

Accordingly, the restoration petition is allowed.

Let C.W.J.C. No. 13618 of 2011 be restored to its original file.
