appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Partha Sarthi, learned GA-4,

for the State.

The petitioner seeks appropriate direction in the nature of
mandamus to the District Establishment Committee, West
Champaran at Bettiah to consider the case of the petitioner for
appointment on compassionate ground on Class III post.
According to the petitioner, he was forced to accept Class IV post.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and
considering that the appointment was provided to the petitioner
vide order dated 10.3.2008 and the petitioner has willingly



accepted the same without raising any murmur, I am not persuaded to grant any relief to the petitioner almost after nine years of having accepted the appointment. Should the petitioner seek appointment on Class III post, it would be open to him to strive for it departmentally as and when such examination is held.

The writ petition is disposed of.
