At the very outset, it has been pointed out that in view of the judgment delivered by a Bench of this Court in the case of ***Chini Thakur vs. Union of India*** reported as ***2014 (3) PLJR 724***, the present writ application is not maintainable, at this stage, since the matter relating to employment under the Railways is required to be first agitated before the Central Administrative Tribunal.
