Inter alia contending that cases instituted in the police station by the police officials are not being investigated in accordance with the requirement of the Police Manual and the same is being done in violation of Police Order 175, this petition has been filed by the petitioner directly in public interest claiming himself to be a vigilant citizen.

Except for making such vague allegations, it is seen that neither the issue has been raised with the competent authorities of the State Government nor any instances or examples of violation



have been pointed in the petition.

Taking note of all these factors, we are not inclined to interfere into the matter on such an unspecified and vague allegation in the petition.

Liberty shall be available to the petitioner to take up the issue first with the State Government and thereafter to come to this Court after making specific statements with adequate materials in support of the pleadings with statistical figures and other details.

With the aforesaid, this application is disposed of.
