ORAL ORDER

3 03-05-2017 None appears for the appellant. Defects pointed by the office have not been rectified.

However, Sri Amit Srivastava, learned counsel appearing for the State Election Commission points out that with regard to the same election for the Panchayat in question, Letters Patent Appeal No.1545 of 2016 (Veena Devi v. The State of Bihar & Ors.) has been dismissed by this Bench on 1st of May, 2017 and for the same reasons, this appeal is also liable to be



dismissed.

Keeping in view the reasons already indicated by us in the order dated 1st May, 2017 passed in Letters Patent Appeal No.1545 of 2016, we see no reason to make any indulgence into the matter.

For the same reason, this appeal is also dismissed with liberty to the aggrieved persons to take remedy of filing of a case before the Election Commission, if available, in law.
