Heard learned counsel for the parties.

The Court in its order dated 10.01.2017 has recorded in detail the *lis* before the Court. However, before the parties could address the Court on merits, learned counsel for the contesting respondents no. 3 and 4 agrees to get the writ petition disposed off confirming the interim stay order so that the main Surcharge Appeal
