The petitioner claims writ of mandamus to establish a District Soldier Board in the District of Rohtas in the light of the decision of the State Government dated 15th November, 2006.

We find that whether a District Soldier Board is required to be established at a particular place or not is a decision of the executive, but since the petitioner relies upon a decision of the State Government, we dispose of the present writ application to take an appropriate follow up action in terms of such decision taken on 15th November, 2006. If the State has other plans, it is open to the



State to establish or not to establish the District Solider Board at a particular place. But no orders are called for in this respect.

Writ application stands disposed of accordingly.
