The contempt application is disposed of with a direction
upon the Managing Director that the arrears of pay revision, which



entitlement is no longer an issue, should now be paid in the following manner:-

(i) The first installment must be paid to the employees by 1st of September, 2017;

(ii) The second installment will follow six months and;

(iii) The final installment thereafter in another six months from the last installment.

The time frame and the indulgence, which has been shown by this Court, must be adhered to especially when 20 years have gone past in the litigation. The Managing Director must keep in mind that the time frame as fixed has to be adhered to.
