when representation submitted to the Circle Officer, Dumra, no
action has been taken, the writ petition has been filed seeking
removal of the encroachment.

Keeping in view the grievance of the petitioner,
for the present, without entering into the controversy, the



petitioner is directed to file a detailed complaint indicating encroachment along with document and a copy of this order before the Circle Officer of the area in question, and the authority shall proceed to take action for removal of encroachment under the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act within a period of six months.

With the aforesaid, this application is disposed of.
