counsel for the State.

In the present case, petitioner is challenging the
initiation of proceeding under the Bihar & Orissa Public
Demands Recovery Act, 1914 as a demand notice of
Rs.80,451/- has been issued against him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner has already filed objection petition under Section
