5. 28-04-2017 Sri Mukeshwar Dayal, learned counsel for the petitioner, after some argument, in presence of Sri Mukund Jee, learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent/State Bank of India, requests for disposal of the present writ petition so that petitioner may approach the authority concerned regarding his prayer for regularization as well payment of minimum wages/ wages for equal work.

The Court is of the opinion that in view of submission made by learned counsel for the petitioner, there is no reason to



keep the matter pending.

The writ petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the authority concerned.

It goes without saying that if such representation is filed with supportive document(s), the authority concerned may examine the same and pass order in accordance with law as well as instruction of the Bank, preferably; within a period of three months from the date of filing of such representation.
