Heard learned counsel for the State.

The impugned order dated 04.12.2015 is not required to be
interfered with keeping in view that the society in question is a Multi-



State Co-operative Society. In view of the same, the Registrar, Co-operative Society, Bihar cannot exercise jurisdiction over that body.

Since the question answered by the learned single Judge is a jurisdictional question and the power of the Registrar to exercise authority which is not seriously contested keeping in view the status of the society, the Appeal has no merit. It is dismissed.
