Delay of 76 days is condoned. I.A. No. 7632 of 2013

is allowed. Thereafter the matter is heard on merits.

Writ petitioner was dismissed from service way back in the year 1989. After almost 14 years, he decides to file writ application and to challenge his dismissal.

If the writ petitioner had reconciled to the situation of his dismissal for more than 14 years, then the Writ Court rightly



refused to exercise his discretion when almost 24 years had passed since the order of dismissal.

No infirmity has been committed by the Writ Court in dismissing such frivolous writ application.

The appeal is dismissed.
